<b>Wed 1-Nov 10:25</b>  7 miles SZ 025 843 BH19 3AZ	<b>Bus No 50 10:05</b>	<b>GREENLAND'S FARM TO NORDEN - LINEAR WALK</b>  Note this is a linear walk, using bus at each end. If you are not resident in Swanage, then get to Swanage in time to park before catching the bus. Take 50 bus from Swanage station. Get off and meet at Goathorn Farm bus stop (postcode is for Greenland's Farm track). Follow Poole Harbour Trail westward via Greenland's Farm, Newton, Wytch Farm, and Sharford Bridge, to finish at Norden. Largely flat, easy walking on paths & tracks across the heath. Catch 40 bus from Norden back to Swanage.	
<b>Sat 4 Nov 10:00</b>  5.5 Miles SY 906 893 BH20 7PE		<b>WAREHAM FOREST SIKA TRAIL WALK</b>  Meet at Sika Trail car park (Bere Road) for a level circular walk around Wareham forest and Morden Bog. Maybe some muddy patches. Note post code is about ½ mile further towards Bere Regis.	
<b>Wed 8 Nov 10:00</b>  5 miles SY 974 776 BH19 3LE		<b>WINSPIT, SEACOMBE &amp; DANCING LEDGE</b>  Meet at Worth Matravers CP. Head South to Winspit then west along coastal path to Dancing Ledge. Go inland to Spyway then return to Worth via Priests Way. Steep steps up from Winspit and down to Seacombe, and a climb inland from Dancing Ledge. Hopefully good coastal views. Option for pub afterwards.

<b>Sat 11 Nov 10:00</b>  5.75 miles SY 814 924 DT2 7HZ		<b>MORETON &amp; AFFPUDDLE HEATH</b>  Meet at Cul-peppers Dish Car Park. Take Jubilee trail to Moreton returning via Two Gates Farm & Affpuddle Heath. Walk on woodland, heath & riverside tracks with a small amount of road walking. Very little ascent or descent. Note - Car park is approx. 400m west of postcode.	
<b>Wed 15 Nov 10:00</b>  6.6 miles SY 923 871 BH20 4LP	<b>Bus No 40 09:00</b>	<b>WAREHAM TO CREECH BOTTOM AND RIDGE</b>  Meet at Wareham Quay. If driving then park in nearby roads. Fairly flat walk via Stoborough, Bog Lane to Creech Bottom. Across the main road to the old tram way. Follow this back to Ridge, RedCliffe and river path to the Quay.	
<b>Sat 18 Nov 10:00</b>  6 miles SU 030 074 BH21 7JA		<b>HORTON CIRCULAR, SOUTHERN FRINGE OF CRANBOURNE CHASE</b>  Meet in layby just after entrance to Horton & Chalbury Village Hall. Circular walk taking in villages of Horton, Chalbury & Chalbury Common, stopping to see Horton Tower & 13th century All Saints Church in Chalbury. Walking through a mixture of fields & copses, with wide views over the downs before descending a sunken woodland path into Horton Valley. Some walking along a country road with grass verges. Option for lunch in the Horton Inn afterwards.	
<b>Wed 22 Nov 10:00</b>  3.5 miles SZ 021 809 BH19 3DG	<b>Bus No 50 09:25</b>	<b>ULWELL CIRCULAR – SHORT VERSION</b>  Meet at first lay-by car park on right hand side of Ulwell Road, just past turning for Ulwell Inn. Short circular walk via Godlingston Manor, Windmill Knap, and Knitson Farm.	
<b>Sat 25 Nov 10:30</b>  5.3 Miles SY 959 824 BH20 5DR	<b>Bus No 40 10:00</b>	<b>CORFE CASTLE – LITTLE WOOLGARSTON – CHALLOW HILL</b>  Park Corfe NT Visitor car park. Walk through Corfe village to edge of Corfe common. Cross main road onto common, over railway towards Woolgarston. Climb up to ridgeway towards telecoms mast ahead. On to top of Challow Hill then back down steep steps into village. Several stiles. Hopefully view of 1245 Polar Express train from Swanage. Option to walk to North Pole ( Norden).	
<b>Wed 29 Nov 10:00</b>  4.5 miles SY 906 893 BH20 7PA		<b>WAREHAM FOREST</b>  Park and start from Sika Trail car park at Coldharbour. Walk through forest and across Hauses Field. Over railway line and North Bridge towards Wareham. Turn right and walk alongside river and through farm. Through forest and cross road back to car park. Flat walking with mainly open views. NB: post code is for the pub which is 500m north west of the Sika Trail CP.
